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CONCEPT

First presented as thesis for the bachelor degree in painting at the Brera Academy of Fine Arts, Amy-d

Arte Spazio Gallery in Milan was chosen for the willingness of the gallery itself and for its interior

spaces, which proved apt for an in-scale reproduction.

Thus was born the mock-up of the space/gallery, created by Zhenru Liang, who is also the curator of

the collective exhibition. In the context of Brera aperta, it becomes the container for various works, all

very different from one another, but all linked by the "small format" theme, always enclosing in the

small size a larger and higher level of expression.

An action that we could call proto-historic, since everything was directly done with purely manual

techniques. After lighting a fire in the open countryside, in a garden in Lenno, on Lake Como, the

artists were able to make their own moulds and live the thrill of melting the metal and pouring it

inside.

Created by the young artists following all steps of the lost wax technique, the bronze, aluminium and

silver castings hold other symbolic meanings, such as the melting/blending, the coming together in a

path that, starting from the matter and the sense of doing, elevates itself to higher levels, blending with

a more spiritual and deep feeling.
